## Additional Information, Services and Prices

### Group Sizes

Minimum numbers apply but, if necessary, we can sometimes combine groups to make up numbers. Please call.

### Firearms Documents/Permits

Visitor weapon permits are £25 per person if you bring your own weapon. We will send you the necessary forms and submit them prior to your arrival.

### Compulsory Hunting Insurance

UK insurance is £30 per person and valid for one year. This is supplementary to your standard travel and medical insurance which each member of your party should arrange personally.

### Weapon Hire

**Rifle Hire:** £30 per rifle per day including bullets.

**Shotgun Hire:** £25 per gun per day

**Shotgun Cartridges:** £6 per 25

Note: A visitor weapons permit is not required for hired weapons

### Professional Gamekeepers, Stalkers, Loaders and Guides

The hunting/shooting area staff generally look after your party very well but, if you prefer a guide to co-ordinate your trip this would cost £250 per day (inclusive of his accommodation and food). He and his vehicle would also be at the disposal of guests should they require it for shopping etc etc. Tips are discretionary - about £30 per person per day.

### Travel Arrangements

You should make your own arrangements to travel to Scotland.

**By Air:** Edinburgh (EDI) and Glasgow (GLA) are served by direct flights from Eastern USA and Canada as well as most major UK and European cities. Other convenient Scottish airports include Aberdeen [UK, Scandinavian and European services], Inverness [Scottish Islands and various UK services] and Dundee [various Scottish, Belfast and London City services]. Note: please try to avoid Glasgow Airport as it usually involves a longer drive through heavier traffic.

**By Rail:** Train services to Edinburgh, Glasgow, Stirling, Perth, Dundee, Aberdeen, Oban, Fort William, Inverness, Kyle of Lochalsh and towns en route from most UK cities and, via Eurostar, most of Europe.

**By Sea:** Ferry service between Rosyth (on the Firth of Forth) and Zeebrugge.

### Transport within Scotland

We will be pleased to arrange transport from your point of arrival to your accommodation and/or your chosen hunting area(s). We usually use 4x4 vehicles which will carry 3 to 4 guests with luggage. Vehicle and driver are charged by the day - please ask for a quote. If you bring or hire your own vehicle, we provide maps and/or GPS directions.

### Accommodation

Accommodation varies according to the location (some hunting areas are very remote). Generally we use traditional lodges, fine country houses or good quality hotels. Prices vary considerably according to type of accommodation, time of year, location, rate plan and whether sharing rooms. We will be pleased to find suitable quotes when we know your requirements. If you prefer to find your own accommodation, it is a condition of your weapons permit that adequate security is provided for your weapons.

### Catering and Hospitality

Generally, we provide elevenses, a picnic lunch, hot drinks throughout the day and a winding-down drink with the hunting/shooting staff. Optionally, we arrange Highland banquets, barbecues and hog-roasts.

### Simulated Game Familiarization Shoots

Optionally, we offer Simulated Game Shoots, with or without expert instructors, to enable hunters and shooters to hone their skills before venturing into the hills and moors. These shoots are also very good ice-breakers which help members of your party to get to know each other in a hunting/shooting situation. Also, a great activity for "rest days".

### Rest Days and Non-Shooter Activities

Scotland is, of course, the home of golf and you are never far from a good golf course. We suggest trying the so-called country courses which can often be every bit as challenging as the much more expensive big-name championship courses. A visit to Scotland is not complete without visit to a malt whisky distillery and, again, you are unlikely to be far from one! We can also arrange heritage tours, Highland safaris, shopping trips and much more.

### Entertainment

We can offer a variety of evening entertainment for your guests - Highland banquets, ceilidhs, musicians, malt whisky tastings, etc. A Highland Bagpiper may be arranged to provide a traditional Scottish welcome for your party.

### Professional Photographic Diary

A successful trip deserves a full visual memento. Our photographer can make a photographic record of your trip. Photographs are available through an online gallery or may be supplied on DVD or in prints up to A2 size.

### UK Taxes
